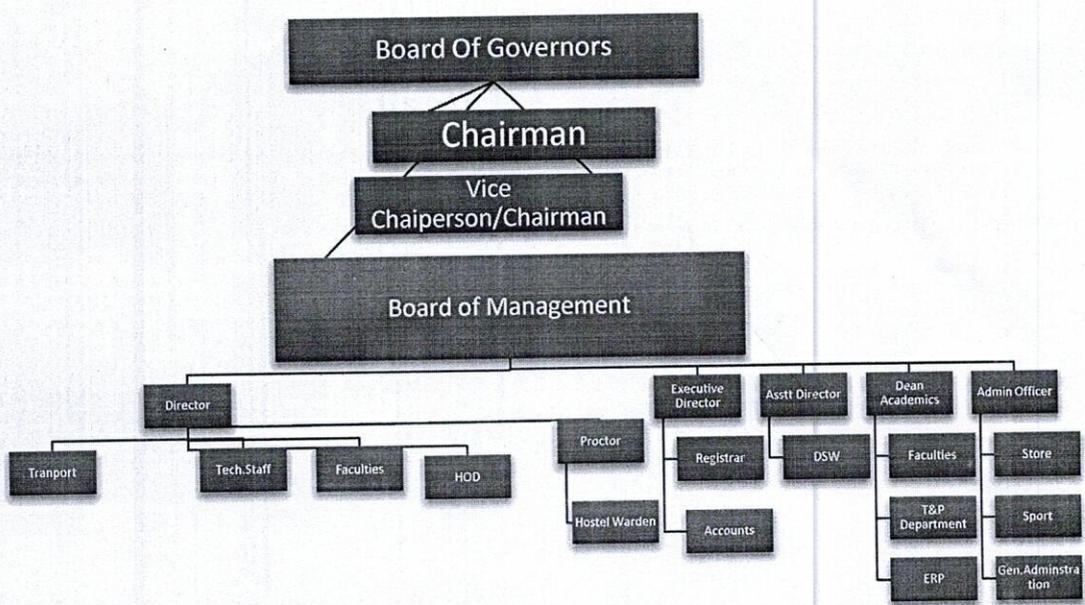

## CONSTITUTION OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India admitted and heard the above referred SLPs in relation to the menace of ragging in Technical Institutions / Universities/ Colleges in the Country. In this connection, a committee headed by Dr. R.K. Raghavan, former Director of CBI, for giving specific recommendations on effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions was constituted by the apex court. Accordingly, the Committee had carried out a very detailed study on the various factors contributing for ragging and collected the public opinion. Further, the Committee had submitted a detailed report with suitable recommendations and measures required to effectively curb the menace. The recommendations of the Committee were duly accepted. The following directives have been issued to all the educational institutes for necessary implementation by the Hon'ble Court and this college proposes to follow them.

### ***I. Factors enlisted by the committee:***

1. Primary responsibility for curbing ragging rests with academic institutions themselves.
2. Ragging adversely impacts the standards of higher education.
3. Incentives should be available to institutions for curbing the menace and there should be disincentives for failure to do so.
4. Enrollment in academic pursuits or a campus life should not immunize any adult citizen from penal provisions of the laws of the land.
5. Ragging needs to be perceived as failure to inculcate human values from the schooling stage.
6. Behavioral patterns among students, particularly potential 'raggers', need to be Measures against ragging must deter its recurrence.
7. Concerted action is required at the level of the school, higher educational institution, district administration, university, State and Central Governments to make any curb effective.
8. Media and the Civil Society should be involved in this exercise.

### ***II. Recommendations approved by the Supreme Court.***

1. The punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
2. Every single incident of ragging where the victim or his parent/guardian or the Head of institution is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, First Information Report

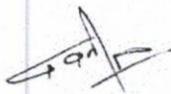

1. **Registration for counselling for admission can be made online only.** Candidates are required to fill the Application Form online through the website <https://uptac.admissions.nic.in>.
2. The starting date of Counselling Registration will be intimated separately on the website: <https://uptac.admissions.nic.in>.
3. Candidates should read this Information Brochure carefully, check their eligibility and applicable reservation category etc. before filling and submitting the application form. Also, it is advised to go through the website <https://uptac.admissions.nic.in> for any latest updates.
4. This counselling is open to the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any institution located in U.P. or whose parents are domicile of U.P. subject to the eligibility conditions given in this Information Brochure. If the candidate has passed qualifying examination from outside U.P., he/she has to upload domicile certificate of his/her parents (**Father OR Mother only**) at the time of registration for the purpose of online verification and to be produced in original at the time of offline verification during physical reporting at the Institute where seat has been allotted.
5. **The seats available in special round counselling are also open to the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any institution located outside U.P. and whose parents (both Father and Mother) are not domicile of U.P. subject to the eligibility conditions given in this Information Brochure.**
6. Please note that candidates DO NOT need to send "Confirmation Page" printed after completion and submission of online application form to the University. 14. If any document/declaration submitted by the candidate is found to be false at any stage, his/her admission shall be cancelled, and he/she may be liable for prosecution under the law. In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be limited to Lucknow courts only.

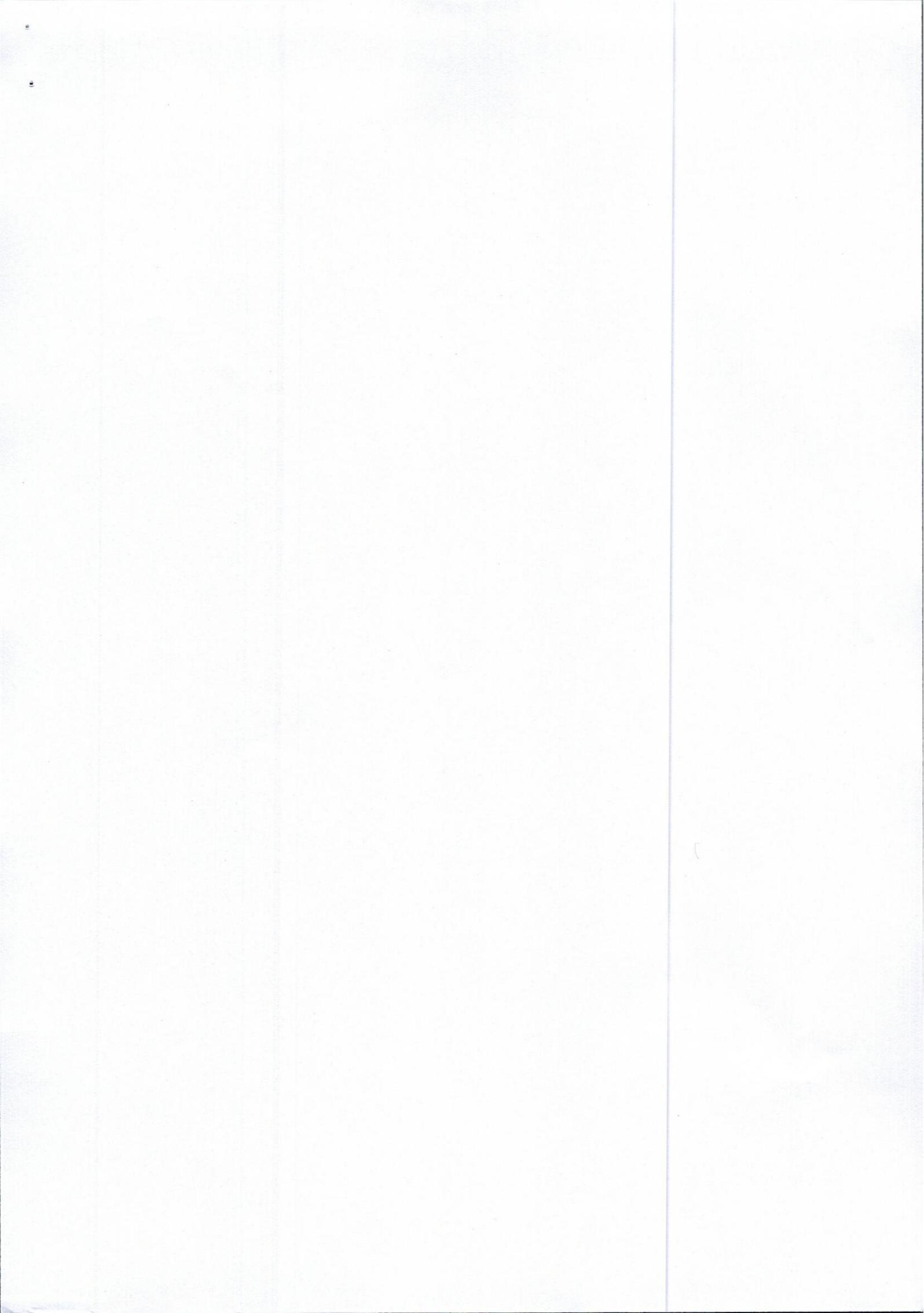
## 2.0 MODE OF ADMISSION

### 2.1 ADMISSION TO FIRST YEAR

The Counselling for admission to first year of the following courses offered at the Institutions affiliated to AKTU, Lucknow including few other universities situated in territory of Uttar Pradesh for the academic year 2025-26 shall be conducted by Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow.

## **2.2 DIRECT ADMISSION (LATERAL ENTRY) TO 2<sup>nd</sup> YEAR OF B. TECH /B. PHARM MCA/ MBA**

- (i) Candidates qualified in exam as per Table-I for B. Tech/B. Pharm/MCA/MBA Lateral Entry can register online for Direct Admission (Lateral Entry) to 2<sup>nd</sup> year of B. Tech/ B. Pharm/ MCA/ MBA courses in the Counselling.
- (ii) The eligible candidates (Refer clause 3) seeking direct admission to second year of B. Tech (for engineering diploma holders and B.Sc. graduates) or B. Pharm (Only for pharmacy diploma holders) or MCA in the Institutions affiliated to Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Technical University(AKTU), Lucknow, and other specified state Universities, are required to register online for counselling before last date. Such seats<sup>1</sup> are limited to a maximum of 10% of previous year sanctioned intake in Institutions/Colleges for different courses at first year level.
- (iii) For B. Tech, the candidates belonging to the B.Sc. stream shall be considered **ONLY AFTER** filling the seats by candidates belonging to Diploma stream.
- (iv) Direct admission to Second year shall not be made in any course other than B. Tech/B. Pharm/MCA/MBA.
- (v) The candidates who have passed qualifying examination from other than Uttar Pradesh State and whose parents are not domicile of Uttar Pradesh State are not eligible for direct admission to second year of B. Tech/B. Pharm/MCA.

## **2.3 SEATS UNDER DIFFERENT SCHEME IN FIRST YEAR**

- (i) UP State Govt. has permitted 15% of total sanctioned seats available in Private Institutions to be filled by the Management quota /NRI candidates; and the same shall be filled up in accordance with the procedure prescribed in the Govt. orders. The remaining seats in various courses offered at the Institutions affiliated to AKTU, Lucknow and other specified state Universities will be filled through the counselling.
- (ii) For Government/ Government Aided/ Government Self-Financed Institutes, 100% seats in all courses in first year will be filled through the counselling as per above clause 2.1.
- (iii) For private colleges 85% seats in all the courses will be filled through counselling as per above clause 2.1.

## **2.4 ADMISSION TO NON-RESIDENT INDIAN (NRI) CANDIDATES IN FIRST YEAR**

NRI candidates, who possess prescribed qualifications (Table-II in clause 3) and merit as per column no. 4 of Table-I, may get direct admission in all UG Courses on 5% seats of total intake in Govt. / Govt. aided and Private Institutions having approval from AICTE for NRI seats on merit, subject to the latest instructions of Govt. of U.P. The detailed information will be published in various newspapers and website <https://uptac.admissions.nic.in/> separately.

## **2.5 ADMISSION TO KASHMIRI<sup>2</sup> MIGRANTS AND KASHMIRI PANDITS/ KASHMIRI HINDU FAMILIES (NON MIGRANTS) LIVING IN KASHMIR VALLEY IN FIRST YEAR**

Direct admission of “Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non- Migrants) Living in Kashmir Valley” candidates, who possess prescribed qualifications (clause 3) and merit as per column no. 4 of Table-I, in first year in each institute is to be made as per the latest instructions of AICTE and orders from U.P. Govt. Such admissions will be over and above the sanctioned intake and normally limited up to one admission per Institute affiliated to AKTU, Lucknow. The detailed information will be published in various newspapers and University website <https://uptac.admissions.nic.in> separately. The B. Arch course does not exist for such candidates.

## **2.6 ADMISSION TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (FN) / PERSONS OF INDIAN ORIGIN (PIO) / OCI / CHILDREN OF INDIAN WORKERS IN GULF COUNTRIES (CIWGC)**

Under the approval of AICTE, identified institutions shall admit FN/PIO/CIWGC up to the extent sanctioned by AICTE as per the eligibility criteria (clause 3) and guidelines of the University. These supernumerary seats shall be exclusively meant for the FN/OCI/PIO/CIWGC students in undergraduate courses with the condition that under no circumstances a seat remained unfilled shall be allocated to candidates other than a FN/OCI/PIO/CIWGC. The candidates, opting for admission under this scheme, need not to appear in any entrance exam. **The B. Arch course does not exist for such candidates.**

## **2.7 ADMISSION TO FEE-WAIVER SEATS FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER MERITORIOUS STUDENTS**

As per the AICTE notification fee waiver seats for economically weaker meritorious candidates are also available in B. Tech/BHMCT/BFAD/BFA/B. Des/B. Pharm/MCA/MBA courses in all institutions affiliated to AKTU, Lucknow. No tuition fee will be charged from the candidates admitted against such seats. The fee waiver seats will be limited to maximum of 5% of the approved intake in the course, and will be over and above of the sanctioned intake. These supernumerary seats shall be available only to such Course(s) in an Institution, where a minimum of 50% of “Approved Intake” are filled up in the last Academic year. To avail this facility candidate must submit certificate no. 12 (Income Certificate) at the time of verification of documents. It should not be confused with EWS Category. **No Tuition Fee Waiver seats are available for B. Arch Courses.**

- (i) A candidate needs to submit mark sheet of the Qualifying Examination declaring him/her PASSED. Moreover, at the time of registration, there MUST NOT be any Repeat-in-Theory/Compartment (which remains un-cleared) in those subjects which are being considered for eligibility as per the Table-II in the clause number 3 above.

- 5.3 The candidates can be given only one type of horizontal reservation out of UPFF/UPAF/UPHC. However, the female candidates can also claim for any one of UPFF/UPAF/UPHC along-with UPGL.
- 5.4 Subsequent request for the change of category / sub-category filled in Application Form shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 5.5 Category/sub-category must be supported by the relevant certificates as per proforma given in Appendix-A to be produced at the time of counselling, failing which the candidates shall be treated in General Category.
- 5.6 The advantage of horizontal reservation in Armed force sub-category is available to sons/ daughters of "defense personnel from U.P. either retired (Superannuated) or killed / disabled in action and the dependents settled in U.P.", and "the defense personnel posted in U.P." on the date of Counselling registration.

## 6.0 WEIGHTAGE TO CANDIDATES FROM RURAL AREAS OF UTTAR PRADESH

- 6.1 A weightage of 3% of the total marks obtained in the entrance exam as per Column 2 of Table-I will be given to such UPGE candidates, for all UG courses, who have passed the qualifying examination from an institution situated in rural area of Uttar Pradesh.
- 6.2 For this purpose, the institutions should be situated in the jurisdiction of Gram Panchayat but the area should not be industrially developed. Such candidates must produce Certificate No. 7 at the time of counselling.
- 6.3 Rural weightage is not applicable for a candidate opting any other reservation and for a candidate opting direct admission to second year.
- 6.4 Rural weightage is not applicable for candidates under UPGD and UPGDEWS category defined in clause 4.3 and 4.8.
